

State of play

Since Cargo Carriers recent import of the eco-friendly fuel distribution Euro IV vehicles, we have been able to reduce fuel consumption (and therefore costs) and carbon emissions while increasing our payload on key contracts. The renewal and regeneration of our fleet is impacting positively both on our business and on the environment.

A further example of environmental awareness is our solar powered depot in Evander. To avoid dependency on the local community's electricity supply, Cargo Carriers erected South Africa's first solar-powered depot in 2010. This self-sufficient and energy-efficient depot has since proved to be instrumental in attracting and winning new business.

In 2010 we formed a joint venture to handle 'last mile' fuel distribution in the Eastern Cape. We were able to bring high BBBEE and SHEQ scores as well as high levels of industry expertise and service to a collaborative partnership, creating the value required to expand. Such are the models on which we base our business relationships.
